

<b>Definition</b>	<b>Sentence Starters</b>	<b>Example</b>
<p><b>Point</b> This one sentence tells the reader what the whole paragraph will be about.</p>	<p><i>Throughout the text/video/.....</i> <i>The text/video states.....</i></p>	
<p><b>Evidence</b> This part is where you tell the reader the evidence that proves the point.</p>	<p><i>An example of this is when.....</i> <i>This is seen when....</i> <i>Evidence of this is...</i> <i>For instance...</i></p>	
<p><b>Explanation</b> This part is where you write in more detail and explain the evidence and how it relates to the point.</p>	<p><i>This shows that...</i> <i>The reason for this is/was...</i> <i>This means that...</i></p>	

<p><b>Link</b> The part is the conclusion. It's usually only one sentence. You need to link it back to the point.</p>	<p><i>In summary....</i> <i>In conclusion...</i> <i>For these reasons, it's clear that...</i></p>	
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REMEMBER:

- Did I capitalize all the correct words?
  - Names? Abbreviations? I?
- Did I write any run-on sentences?
  - Do I use 'and' more than once in a sentence?
  - Do I use the word 'because' more than once in a sentence?
  - Do I use the word 'because' and 'and' in the same sentence?
- Did I use the correct punctuation?
  - , at breaks within a sentence
  - ! at exclamations
  - ? at questions
  - . at the end of the sentence
